to establish a private university under the name and style "**Girijananda Chowdhury University, Assam**" under section 6 of the Assam Private Universities Act, 2007.

Preamble

Whereas it is expedient to establish a private university under the name and style of "**Girijananda Chowdhury University Assam**" under Section 6 of the Assam Private Universities Act, 2007 and for matters connected therewith or incidental.

It is hereby enacted in the Seventy - third Year of the Republic of India as follows.

Short title, extent and commencement

1. (1) This Act may be called **Girijananda Chowdhury University, Assam Act, 2022**.
- (2) It extends to the whole of Assam.
- (3) It shall come into force at once.

Establishment of the Girijananda Chowdhury University Assam

2. (1) For furthering the advancement of learning and prosecution of higher education and research, there shall be established a private university under the name and style "**The Girijananda Chowdhury University Assam**" in the state of Assam.
- (2) The details regarding name, location, jurisdiction and infrastructure of the said University are mentioned in the schedule appended to this Act.

to provide for establishment and incorporation of private universities in the State of Assam for imparting higher education and to regulate their functions and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto.

Preamble

Whereas it is expedient to provide for establishment and incorporation of private Universities in the State of Assam for imparting higher education and to regulate their functions and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto;

It is hereby enacted in the Fifty-eighth Year of the Republic of India, as follows:-

Short title, extent and commencement

1. (1) This Act may be called the Assam Private Universities Act, 2007.
- (2) It extends to the whole of Assam.
- (3) It shall come into force at once.

Definitions

2. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires,-
 - (a) "AICTE" means All India Council of Technical Education established under All India Council of Technical Education Act, 1987;
 - (b) "CSIR" means the Council of Scientific and Industrial Research, New Delhi, a funding agency of the Central Government;
 - (c) "DEC" means the Distance Education Council established under section 28 of Indira Gandhi National Open University Act, 1985;
 - (d) "distance education" means education imparted by combination of any two or more means of communication, viz. broadcasting, telecasting, correspondence courses, seminars, contact programmes and any other such methodology;
 - (e) "DST" means the Department of Science and Technology of the Central Government;
 - (f) "employee" means a person appointed by the university to work in the university, colleges, institutions or study centers and includes teachers, officers (other than the Visitor) and other employees of the university;
 - (g) "fee" means collection made by the university from the students by whatever name it may be called, which is not refundable;
 - (h) "Government" means the State Government of Assam;
 - (i) "higher education" means study of a curriculum or course for the pursuit of knowledge beyond 10+2 level;
 - (j) "hostel" means a place of residence for the students of the university, or its colleges, institutions or centers, maintained or recognized to be as such by the university;
 - (k) "ICAR" means the Indian Council of Agriculture Research, a society registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860;
 - (l) "MCI" means Medical Council of India, Delhi;
 - (m) "NAAC" means the National Council of Assessment and Accreditation, Bangalore, an autonomous institution of the UGC;

- (n) "NCTE" means the National Council of Teacher Education, Delhi;
- (o) "off campus centre" means a centre of the university established by it outside the main campus operated and maintained as its constituent unit, having the university's complement of facilities, faculty and staff;
- (p) "PCI" means Pharmaceutical Council of India, Delhi;
- (q) "prescribed" means prescribed by rules made under this Act;
- (r) "regulating body" means a body established by the Central Government for laying down norms and conditions for ensuring academic standards of higher education, such as UGC, AICTE, NCTE, MCI, PCI, NAAC, ICAR, DEC, CSIR etc. and includes the State Government;
- (s) "Rules" means the rules made under this Act;
- (t) "Schedule" means the Schedule to this Act;
- (u) "sponsoring body" in relation to a university established under this Act means-
- (i) a society registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860; Central Act No. 21 of 1860
- or
- (ii) any public trust registered under the Indian Trusts Act, 1882; Central Act No. 2 of 1882
- or
- (iii) a company registered under section 25 of the Companies Act, 1956; Central Act No. 1 of 1956
- (v) "Statutes", "Ordinances" and "Regulations" mean respectively, the Statutes, Ordinances and Regulations of the University made under this Act;
- (w) "student of the university" means a person enrolled in the university for taking a course of study for a degree, diploma or other academic distinction duly instituted by the university, including a research degree;
- (x) "study centre" means a centre established and maintained or recognized by the university, for the purpose of advising, counselling or for rendering any other assistance required by the students in the context of distance education;
- (y) "teacher" means a Professor, Reader, Lecturer or any other person required to impart education or to guide research or to render guidance in any other form to the students for pursuing a course of study of the university;
- (z) "UGC" means the University Grants Commission, established under the University Grants Commission Act, 1956; Central Act No.3 of 1956
- (za) "university" means a university established and incorporated under section 6.

Objects of

3. Following shall be the objects of the university, namely:-

- (1) to provide instructions, teaching and training in Higher Education and make provisions for research, advancement and dissemination of knowledge;
- (2) to create higher levels of intellectual abilities;
- (3) to establish state of the art facilities for education and training;
- (4) to carry out teaching and research and offer continuing education programmes;
- (5) to create centres of excellence for research and development and for sharing knowledge and its application;
- (6) to establish campus in Assam and to have study centers at different places within its jurisdiction;
- (7) to establish examination centres;
- (8) to institute degrees, -diplomas, certificates and other academic distinctions on the basis of examination, or any such other method;
- (9) to ensure that the standard of degrees, diplomas, certificates and other academic distinctions are not lower than those laid down by AICTE, NCTE, UGC, MCI, Pharmacy Council, and other similar agency/ agencies established by the Central Government for regulation of education;
- (10) to open study centers within its jurisdiction;
- (11) to set up off campus centre within and out of the State, subject to the permission of the regulatory bodies under any law made by the Parliament and any regulation, rules etc. made by the regulating bodies;
- (12) to pursue any other objective as may be approved by the Government.

4. (1) An application containing the proposal and the project report to establish a university in private sector shall be made by the sponsoring body to the State Government, alongwith such fee as may be prescribed.
- (2) The project report must contain the following particulars, namely:-
- (a) the details of the sponsoring body alongwith the copies of its registration certificate, constitution and bye-laws;
 - (b) the information regarding financial resources of the sponsoring body alongwith audited accounts for the past five years;
 - (c) the name, location and headquarters of the proposed university;
 - (d) the objectives of the university;
 - (e) the availability of land and details of buildings and infrastructure facilities, if already exist and details of land,

- building and other infrastructure proposed to be owned or created as required under the provisions of this Act;
- (f) availability of academic facilities including teaching and non-teaching staff, if any, at the disposal of sponsoring body;
- (g) the details of plans for campus development such as construction of buildings, development of structural amenities and infrastructure facilities and procurement of equipment etc. to be undertaken before the university starts functioning and phased programme for first five years;
- (h) the phased outlays of capital expenditure proposed for the next five years and its sources of finance;
- (i) the nature and the type of programmes of study and research proposed to be undertaken by the university and their relevance to the development goals and employment needs of the State and phasing of such programmes over the first five years with course-wise enrolment targets;
- (j) the experience and expertise in the concerned disciplines at the command of the sponsoring body;
- (k) the nature of facilities, courses of study and research proposed to be started;
- (l) the estimated recurring expenditure course-wise or activity-wise, sources of finance and estimated expenditure per student;
- (m) the scheme for mobilizing resources and the cost of capital thereto and the manner of repayment to such sources;
- (n) the scheme for the generation of funds internally through the recovery of fee from students, revenues anticipated from consultancy services and other activities relating to the objects of the university, and other anticipated incomes;
- (o) the proposed fee structure with reference to the details of expenditure on unit cost and the extent of concessions or rebates in fee or free-ships and scholarships to the poor students from economically poor or socially backward families, including Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes and handicapped students;
- (p) the system proposed to be followed for selecting students for admission to the courses of study at the university;
- (q) the system proposed to be followed for appointment of teachers and other employees in the university;
- (r) whether the university is desirous of taking up distance education programme. If so, details of study centres proposed to be started;

- (s) whether the university proposes to undertake some programmes related to local needs. If so, the nature of specialized teaching, training or research activities to be undertaken by the university so as to fulfill this objective;
- (t) whether the university proposes to start some programmes for the benefit of farmers, women and industries. If so, details thereof may be given;
- (u) details of play grounds and other facilities available or proposed to be created for games and sports and extra curricular activities like National Cadet Corps, National Service Scheme, Scouts and Guides etc;
- (v) the arrangements proposed to be made for academic auditing;
- (w) justification regarding the necessity of establishment of the proposed university;
- (x) commitment to follow the norms of the regulating bodies;
- (y) such other details as the sponsoring body may like to give;
- (z) such other details as may be prescribed.
- (3) The State Government, on receipt of the proposal and the project report for establishment of a university, shall constitute a committee consisting of such members as may be specified by it, out of whom at least one shall be an expert, to examine the proposal and the project report.

Explanation: - In this sub-section the expression "expert" means an academician of prominence in the respective field of higher education.

- (4) The committee shall consider the proposal and the project report on the following grounds, namely: -
- (a) financial soundness and assets of the sponsoring body and its ability to set up the infrastructure of the proposed university;
- (b) back ground of the sponsoring body, that is to say, its expertise and experience in the field of education, its general reputation etc, and its commitment to follow the norms of the regulating bodies;
- (c) potentiality of the courses proposed to be offered, that is to say, the courses are able to develop the human resources as per the requirements of contemporary demands, the courses have new features and include emerging branches of learning;
- (5) The committee, while considering the proposal and the project report under sub-section (4), may call for such other information from the sponsoring body as it thinks proper for the purpose.

(6) The committee shall submit its report to the State Government within a period of one month from the date of its constitution:

Provided that while computing the period of one month, the period commencing from the date on which requisition for any information under sub-section (5) is issued and ending on the date on which requisite information is submitted to the committee shall be excluded.

5. Issuance of the letter of intent and compliance report

(1) After the receipt of the report of the committee constituted under section 4, if the State Government is satisfied that it is advisable to establish the university, it may issue a letter of intent and ask the sponsoring body to-

(i) establish an endowment fund in accordance with the provisions of section 11 of this Act;

(ii) own a minimum of 20 acres of land outside municipal area or 10 acres within municipal area, if not already available;

(iii) construct a minimum of 10,000 square meters of covered space for administrative purposes and for conducting academic programmes, if not already available;

(iv) purchase books and journals of atleast rupees 10 lacs or as per the norms of regulating bodies, whichever is higher, and give undertaking to invest within first three years not less than rupees 50 lacs or as per the norms of regulating bodies, whichever is higher, on books, journals, computers, library networking and other facilities, so as to make the library facilities adequate for contemporary teaching and research;

(v) purchase equipments, computers, furniture, other mobile and immobile assets and infrastructure facilities (other than buildings, referred to in clause (iii) above) worth rupees 20 lacs or as per the norms of regulating bodies, whichever is higher, and give undertaking to procure within the first five years equipments, computers, furniture, other mobile and immobile assets and infrastructure facilities (other than buildings, referred to in clause (iii) above) worth not less than rupees one crore or as per the norms of regulating bodies, whichever is higher;

(vi) give undertaking to appoint at least 1 Professor, 2 Readers and adequate number of Lecturers along with necessary supporting staff in each department or discipline to be started by the university;

(vii) give undertaking to take up co-curricular activities like seminars, debates, quiz programmes and extracurricular

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activities like games, sports, National Service Scheme, National Cadet Corps, Scouts and Guides etc. for the benefit of students as per the norms laid down by the regulating bodies;

(viii) give undertaking for establishment of provident fund and to take up welfare programmes for the employees of the university; and

(ix) fulfill such other conditions and provide such other information as may be prescribed by the University Grants Commission, All India Council for Technical Education or any other statutory body established by the law of the Union or State Government.

(2) The sponsoring body shall fulfil the requirements and conditions specified in sub-section (1) and shall report the compliance to the State Government within a maximum period of two year from the date of issue of the letter of intent. On receiving the compliance report, the State Government shall appoint a committee consisting of such members, including the representative of the regulating bodies, as may be specified, to verify the compliance report. The committee shall submit its report to the State Government within one month from the date of its constitution specifying whether the sponsoring body has fulfilled the requirements and conditions laid down in sub-section (1).

(3) If the sponsoring body has failed to comply with the provisions of sub-section (2), its proposal submitted under section 4 shall stand rejected and the letter of intent issued under sub-section (1) shall be deemed to have been withdrawn.

Establishment
of the
University

6. The Government, if satisfied, after considering the report submitted under sub-section (2) of section 5 that the sponsoring body has complied with the provisions of sub-section (1) of section 5, may, by an Act of the State Legislature, establish a private university with such name, location, jurisdiction and with such infrastructure as may be specified in the Schedule.

Incorporation
of the
University

7. Every university established by an Act of the State Legislature under section 6 shall be a body corporate by the name as specified in the Act and shall have perpetual succession and a common seal. It shall have the power to acquire and hold properly both movable and immovable and to make contract, and may sue and be sued by the said name.

University to
be self-
financed

8. The university shall be self financed and shall not be entitled to receive any grant or other financial assistance from the State Government.


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Requirement
of land

9. No university shall be established unless the sponsoring body is in possession of

- (i) a minimum of twenty acres, i.e. 60.50 Bighas of land outside the municipal limits; or
- (ii) a minimum of ten acres, i.e. 30.25 Bighas of land within the municipal limits.

No power to
affiliate any
college or
institution.

10. The University shall not admit any college or institution to the privilege of affiliation

Endowment
Fund

11. (1) The sponsoring body shall establish an Endowment Fund for the university with an amount of -

- (i) one crore rupees in case the university is situated in Scheduled Tribes area;
- (ii) in other cases, two crore rupees.

(2) The Endowment Fund shall be used as security deposit to ensure that the university complies with the provisions of this Act and functions as per provisions of this Act, Statutes and Ordinances. The Government shall have the powers to forfeit in the prescribed manner, a part or whole of the Endowment Fund in case the university or the sponsoring body contravenes the provisions of this Act or Statutes, Ordinances, Regulations or rules made there under.

(3) Income from Endowment Fund may be utilised for development of infrastructure of the university but shall not be utilised to meet out the recurring expenditure of the university.

(4) The amount of Endowment Fund shall be invested and kept invested until the dissolution of the university in long term securities issued or guaranteed by the State Government or deposited and kept deposited until the dissolution of the university in the interest bearing Personal Deposit account in Government Treasury.

(5) In case of investment in long term security, the certificates of the securities shall be kept in the safe custody of the State Government and in case of deposit in the interest bearing Personal Deposit account in Government Treasury, deposit shall be made with the condition that the amount shall not be withdrawn without the permission of the State Government.

12. Every university shall establish a fund, which shall be called the General Fund to which following shall be credited, namely:-



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General
Fund



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- (a) fees and other charges received by the university;
- (b) any contributions made by the sponsoring body;
- (c) any income received from consultancy and other work undertaken by the university in pursuance of its objectives;
- (d) trusts, bequests, donations, endowments and any other grants; and
- (e) all other sums received by the university.

**Application

13. The General Fund shall be utilized for the following objects, namely:-
- (a) for the repayment of debts including interest charges thereto incurred by the university for the purposes of this Act and the Statutes, Ordinances, Regulations and rules made thereunder;
 - (b) to upkeep of the assets of the university;
 - (c) for the payment of the cost of audit of the funds created under sections 11 and 12;
 - (d) for the meeting expenses of any suit or proceedings to which university is a party ;
 - (e) for the payment of salaries and allowances of the officers and employees of the university and members of the teaching and research staff, and for payment of any Provident Fund contributions, gratuity and other benefits to any such officers and employees, and members of the teaching and research staff;
 - (f) for the payment of travelling and other allowances of the members of the Governing Body, the Board of Management, the Academic Council, and other authorities so declared under the Statutes of the university and of the members of any committee appointed by any of the authorities or by the Chairperson of the sponsoring body or the Vice-Chancellor, as the case may be, of the university in pursuance of any provision of this Act, or the Statutes, Ordinances, Regulations or rules made thereunder;
 - (g) for the payment of fellowships, freships, scholarships, assistantships and other awards to students belonging to economically weaker sections of the society or research associates or trainees, as the case may be, or to any student otherwise eligible for such awards under the Statues, Ordinances, Regulations or rules made under the provisions of this Act;
 - (h) for the payment of any expenses incurred by the university in carrying out the provisions of this Act or the Statutes, Ordinances, Regulations or rules made thereunder;



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- (i) for the payment of cost of capital, not exceeding the prevailing bank rates of interest, incurred by the sponsoring body for setting up the university and the investments made therefor;
- (j) for the payment of charges and expenditure relating to the consultancy work undertaken by the university in pursuance of the provisions of this Act and the rules, Statutes or Ordinances made thereunder;
- (k) for the payment of any other expenses including service fee payable to any organization charged with the responsibility of providing any specific service, including the managerial services to the university, on behalf of the sponsoring body, as approved by the Board of Management to be an expense for the purposes of the university;

Provided that no expenditure shall be incurred by the university in excess of the limits for total recurring expenditure and total non-recurring expenditure for the year, as may be fixed by the Board of Management, without the prior approval of the Board of Management:

Provided further that the General Fund shall, for the objects specified under sub-clause (a), be applied with the prior approval of the Governing Body of the university.

Officers of 14.

The following shall be the officers of the university, namely:-

- (1) the Visitor;
- (2) the Chancellor;
- (3) the Vice-Chancellor;
- (4) the Registrar;
- (5) the Chief Finance and Accounts Officer;
- (6) such other officers as may be declared by the Statutes to be the officers of the University.

Power of 15.
Visitors

- (1) The Governor of Assam shall be the Visitor of the university.
- (2) The Visitor shall, when present, preside at the convocation of the university for conferring degrees and diplomas. The Visitor shall have the following powers, namely:-
 - (a) to call for any paper or information relating to the affairs of the university;
 - (b) on the basis of the information received by the Visitor, if he is satisfied that any order, proceeding, or decision taken by any authority of the university is not in conformity with the

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provisions of this Act or Statutes, Ordinances, Regulations and rules made thereunder, he may issue such directions as he may deem fit in the interest of the university and the directions so issued shall be complied with by the university.

The
Chancellor

16. (1) The Chancellor shall be appointed by the sponsoring body for a period of three years with the approval of the visitor by following such procedure and on such terms and conditions as may be prescribed by the Statutes.
- (2) The Chancellor shall be the head of the university.
- (3) The Chancellor shall preside at the meetings of the Governing Body and shall, when the Visitor is not present, preside at the convocation of the university for conferring degrees, diplomas or other academic distinctions.
- (4) The Chancellor shall have the following powers, namely:-
- to call for any information or record;
 - to appoint the Vice-Chancellor;
 - to remove the Vice-Chancellor in accordance with the provisions of sub-section (7) of section 17;
 - such other powers as may be prescribed by the Statutes.

The Vice-
Chancellor

17. (1) The Vice-Chancellor shall be appointed by the Chancellor from a panel of three persons recommended by the Governing Body and shall, subject to the provisions contained in sub-section (7), hold office for a term of three years:

Provided that, after expiry of the term of three years, a person shall be eligible for re-appointment for another term of three years:

Provided further that a Vice-Chancellor shall continue to hold the office even after expiry of his term till new Vice-Chancellor joins. However, in any case this period shall not exceed one year.

- (2) The Vice-Chancellor shall be the principal executive and academic officer of the university and shall exercise general superintendence and control over the affairs of the university and shall execute the decisions of various authorities of the university.
- (3) The Vice-Chancellor shall preside at the convocation of the university in the absence of both, the Visitor and the Chancellor.
- (4) If in the opinion of the Vice-Chancellor it is necessary to take immediate action on any matter for which powers are conferred on any other authority by or under this Act, he may take such action as he deems necessary and shall at the earliest opportunity thereafter report his action to such officer or authority as would have in the ordinary course dealt with the matter:



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Provided that if in the opinion of the concerned officer or authority such action should not have been taken by the Vice-Chancellor then such case shall be referred to the Chancellor, whose decision thereon shall be final:

Provided further that where any such action taken by the Vice-Chancellor affects any person in the service of the university, such person shall be entitled to prefer, within three months from the date on which such action is communicated to him, an appeal to the Board of Management and the Board of Management may confirm or modify or reverse the action taken by the Vice-Chancellor.

- (5) If, in the opinion of the Vice-Chancellor, any decision of any authority of the university is outside the powers conferred by this Act or Statutes, Ordinances, Regulations or rules made thereunder or is likely to be prejudicial to the interests of the university, he shall request the concerned authority to revise its decision within fifteen days from the date of its decision and in case the authority refuses to revise such decision wholly or partly or fails to take any decision within fifteen days, then such matter shall be referred to the Chancellor and his decision thereon shall be final.
- (6) The Vice-Chancellor shall exercise such powers and perform such duties as may be prescribed by the Statutes or the Ordinances.
- (7) If, at any time upon representation made or otherwise and after making such inquiry as may be deemed necessary, the situation so warrants and if the continuance of the Vice-Chancellor is not in the interests of the University, the Chancellor may, by an order in writing stating the reasons therein, ask the Vice-Chancellor to relinquish his office from such date as may be specified in the order:

Provided that before taking an action under this sub-section, the Vice-Chancellor shall be given an opportunity of being heard.

The Registrar



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18. (1) The appointment of the Registrar shall be made by the Chairperson of the sponsoring body in such manner, as may be prescribed by the Statutes.
- (2) All contracts shall be signed and all documents and records shall be authenticated by the Registrar on behalf of the university.
- (3) The Registrar shall be the Member Secretary of the Governing Body, the Board of Management and Academic Council but shall not have a right to vote.
- (4) The Registrar shall exercise such other powers and perform such other duties as may be prescribed by the Statutes.

19. (1) The appointment of the Chief Finance and Accounts Officer shall be made by the Chancellor in such manner as may be prescribed by the Statutes.
- (2) The Chief Finance and Accounts Officer shall exercise such powers and perform such duties as may be prescribed by the Statutes.
20. (1) The university may appoint such other officers as may be necessary for its functioning.
- (2) The manner of appointment of other officers of the university and their powers and functions shall be such as may be prescribed by the Statutes.
21. The following shall be the authorities of the university, namely:-
- (1) the Governing Body;
 - (2) the Board of Management;
 - (3) the Academic Council;
 - (4) such other authorities as may be declared by the Statutes to be the authorities of the university.
22. (1) The Governing Body of the university shall consist of the following, namely:-
- (a) the Chancellor;
 - (b) the Vice-Chancellor;
 - (c) five persons nominated by the sponsoring body out of whom two shall be eminent educationists;
 - (d) one expert of management or information technology from outside the university, nominated by the Chancellor; and
 - (e) one expert of finance, nominated by the Chancellor.
- (2) The Governing Body shall be the supreme authority of the university. All the movable and immovable property of the university shall vest in the Governing Body. It shall have the following powers, namely:-
- (a) to provide general superintendence and directions and to control functioning of the university by using all such powers as are provided by this Act or the Statutes, Ordinances, Regulations or rules made thereunder;
 - (b) to review the decisions of other authorities of the university in case they are not in conformity with the provisions of this Act or the Statutes, Ordinances, Regulations or rules made thereunder;
 - (c) to improve the budget and annual report of the university;
 - (d) to lay down the extensive policies to be followed by the university;

- (e) to recommend to the sponsoring body about the voluntary liquidation of the university if a situation arises when smooth functioning of the university does not remain possible, inspite of all efforts;
- (f) such other powers as may be prescribed by the Statutes.
- (3) The Governing Body shall meet at least three times in a calendar year.
- (4) The quorum for meetings of the Governing Body shall be four.
23. (1) The Board of Management shall consist of the following members, namely:-
- the Vice-Chancellor;
 - two members of the Governing Body, nominated by the sponsoring body;
 - three persons, who are not the members of the Governing Body, nominated by the sponsoring body;
 - three persons from amongst the teachers, nominated by the sponsoring body;
 - Two teachers, nominated by the Vice-Chancellor.
- (2) The Vice-Chancellor shall be the Chairperson of the Board of Management.
- (3) The powers and functions of the Board of Management shall be such as may be prescribed by the Statutes.
- (4) The Board of Management shall meet once in every two months.
- (5) The quorum for meetings of the Board of Management shall be five.
- The Academic Council
24. (1) The Academic Council shall consist of the Vice-Chancellor and such other members as may be prescribed by the Statutes.
- (2) The Vice-Chancellor shall be the Chairperson of the Academic Council.
- (3) The Academic Council shall be the principal academic body of the university and shall, subject to the provisions of this Act and the rules, Statutes or Ordinances, made thereunder, co-ordinate and exercise general supervision over the academic policies of the university.
- (4) The quorum for meetings of the Academic Council shall be such as may be prescribed by the Statutes.
- Other Authorities
25. The composition, constitution, powers and functions of other authorities of the university shall be such as may be prescribed by the Statutes.


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- Disqualification for membership of an authority or body
26. A person shall be disqualified for being a member of any of the authorities or bodies of the university, if he/she-
- is of unsound mind and stands so declared by a competent court;
 - is an undischarged insolvent;
 - has been convicted of any offence involving moral turpitude;
 - is conducting or engaging himself in private coaching classes; or
 - has been punished for indulging in or promoting unfair practice in the conduct of any examination, in any form, anywhere.
- Vacancies not to invalidate the proceedings of any authority or body of the University
27. No act or proceeding of any authority or body of the university shall be invalid merely by reason of any vacancy or defect in the constitution thereof.
- Filling up of emergent vacancies
28. Any vacancies occurred in the membership of any authority or body of the university due to death, resignation or removal of a member or due to change of capacity in which he was appointed or nominated, shall be filled up as early as possible by the person or the body who had appointed or nominated such a member:
- Provided that the person appointed or nominated as a member of an authority or body of the university on an emergent vacancy, shall remain member of such authority or body for only the remaining period of the member, in whose place he is appointed or nominated.
- Committee
29. The authorities or officers of the university may constitute such committees with such terms of reference as may be necessary for specific tasks to be performed by such committees. The constitution of such committees and their duties shall be such as may be prescribed by the Statutes.
- The First Statutes
30. (1) Subject to the provisions of this Act, and the rules made thereunder, the First Statutes of the university may provide for all or any of the following matters, namely:-
- the constitution, powers and functions of the authorities and other bodies of the university as may be constituted from time to time;
 - the terms and conditions of appointment of the Vice-Chancellor and his powers and functions;
 - the manner and terms and conditions of appointment of the Registrar and Chief Finance and Accounts Officer and their powers and functions;


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- (d) the manner and terms and conditions of appointment of other officers and teachers and their powers and functions;
 - (e) the terms and conditions of service of employees of the university;
 - (f) the procedure for arbitration in case of disputes between officers, teachers, employees and students;
 - (g) the conferment of honorary degrees;
 - (h) the provisions regarding exemption of students from payment of tuition fee and for awarding to them scholarships and fellowships;
 - (i) provisions regarding the policy of admissions, including regulation of reservation of seats;
 - (j) provisions regarding fees to be charged from students; and
 - (k) provisions regarding number of seats in different courses.
- (2) The First Statutes of the university shall be made by the Governing Body and shall be submitted to the State Government for its approval.
- (3) The State Government shall consider the First Statutes, submitted by the university and shall give its approval thereon within two months from the date of its receipt and with such modifications if any, as it may deem necessary.
- (4) The university shall communicate its agreement to the First Statutes as approved by the State Government, and if it desires not to give effect to any or all of the modifications made by the State Government under sub-section (3), it may give reasons therefore and after considering such reason, the State Government may or may not accept the suggestions made by the university.
- (5) The State Government shall publish the First Statutes, as finally approved by it, in the Official Gazette, and thereafter, the first Statutes shall come into force from the date of such publication.

Subsequent
Statutes

31. (1) Subject to the provisions of this Act and the Rules made thereunder, the subsequent Statutes of the university may provide for all or any of the following matters, namely:-
- (a) creation of new authorities of the university;
 - (b) accounting policy and financial procedure;
 - (c) representation of teachers in the authorities of the university;
 - (d) creation of new departments and abolition or restructuring of existing department;
 - (e) institution of medals and prizes;
 - (f) creation of posts and procedure for abolition of posts;


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(g) revision of fees;

(h) alteration of the number of seats in different syllabi; and

(i) all other matters which under the provisions of this Act are to be prescribed by the Statutes.

(2) The Statutes of the university other than the First Statutes shall be made by the Board of Management with the approval of the Governing Body.

(3) The Statutes made under sub-section (2) shall be sent to the State Government and the State Government may approve them as such or, if it considers necessary, give suggestions for modifications in them within two months from the date of receipt of the Statutes.

(4) The Governing Body shall consider the modifications suggested by the State Government and return the Statutes to the State Government with its agreement to such changes or with its comments on the suggestions made by the State Government.

(5) The State Government shall consider the comments of the Governing Body and shall approve the Statutes with or without modifications and then the Statutes as finally approved by the State Government shall be published by it in the Official Gazette, and upon such publication the statutes shall come into force.

The First 32.
Ordinances

(1) Subject to the provisions of this Act or the rules or Statutes made thereunder, the First Ordinances may provide for all or any of the following matters, namely:-

(a) the admission of students to the university and their enrolment as such;

(b) the courses of study to be laid down for the degrees, diplomas and certificates of the university;

(c) the award of the degrees, diplomas, certificates and other academic distinctions, the minimum qualifications for the same and the means to be taken relating to the granting and obtaining of the same;

(d) the conditions for award of fellowships, scholarships, stipends, medals and prizes;

(e) the conduct of examinations, including the terms of office and manner of appointment and the duties of examining bodies, examiners and moderators;

(f) fees to be charged for the various courses examinations, degrees and diplomas of the university;

(g) the conditions of residence of the students of the university;

(h) provision regarding disciplinary action against the students;



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- (i) the creation, composition and functions of any other body which is considered necessary for improving the academic life of the university;
 - (j) the manner of co-operation and collaboration with other universities and institutions of higher education;
 - (k) all other matters which by this Act or Statutes made thereunder are required to be provided by the Ordinances.
- (2) The First Ordinances of the university shall be made by the Vice-Chancellor which after being approved by the Board of Management, shall be submitted to the State Government for its approval.
- (3) The State Government shall consider the First Ordinances submitted by the Vice-Chancellor under sub-section (2) within two months from the date of their receipt and shall either approve them or give suggestions for modifications therein.
- (4) The Vice-Chancellor shall either modify the Ordinances incorporating the suggestion of the State Government or give reasons for not incorporating any of the suggestions made by the State Government and shall return the First Ordinances along with such reasons, if any, to the State Government and on receipt of the same, the State Government shall consider the comments of the Vice-Chancellor and shall approve the First Ordinances of the university with or without such modifications and then the First Ordinances, as approved by the State Government shall be published by the State Government in the Official Gazette and upon such publication the Ordinances shall come into force.
33. (1) All Ordinances other than the First Ordinances shall be made by the Academic Council which after being approved by the Board of Management shall be submitted to the State Government for its approval.
- (2) The State Government shall consider the Ordinances submitted by the Academic Council under sub-section (1) within two months from the date of their receipt and shall approve them or give suggestion for modifications therein.
- (3) The Academic Council shall either modify the Ordinances incorporating the suggestion of the State Government or give reasons for not incorporating any of the suggestions made by the State Government and shall return the Ordinances along with such reason, if any, to the State Government and on receipt of the same, the State Government shall consider the comments of the Academic

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Council and shall approve the Ordinances with or without modifications and then the Ordinances, as approved by the State Government, shall be published by the State Government in the Official Gazette and upon such publication the Ordinances shall come into force.

Regulations 34. The authorities of the university may, subject to the prior approval of the Board of Management, make regulations, consistent with this Act and the rules, Statutes and the Ordinances made thereunder, for the conduct of their own business and that of the committees appointed by them.

Admissions 35. (1) Admission in the university shall be made strictly on the basis of merit:

Provided that for the purpose of filling minority quota in the university established and administered by minority community, zone of consideration for determination of merit shall be limited only to the students belonging to that minority community.

(2) Merit for admission in the university may be determined either on the basis of marks or grade obtained in the qualifying examination and achievements in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities or on the basis of marks or grade obtained in the entrance test conducted at state level either by an association of the universities conducting similar courses or by any agency of the State:

Provided that admission in professional and technical courses shall be made only through entrance test.

(3) Seats for admission in the university of the students belonging to scheduled castes, scheduled tribes and other backward classes and women and handicapped students shall be reserved as per the policy of the State Government.

Fee structure 36. (1) The university may, from time to time, prepare its fee structure and send it for approval of the Committee constituted for the purpose under section 29 or any other law for the time being in force.

(2) The Committee shall consider the fee structure prepared by the university and if it is satisfied that the proposed fees is-

(a) sufficient for-

(i) generating resources for meeting the recurring expenditure of the university; and

(ii) the savings required for the further development of the university; and

(b) not unreasonably excessive, it may approve the fee structure.



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(3) The fee structure approved by the Committee under sub-section (2) shall remain in force for three years and the university shall be entitled to charge fees in accordance with such fee structure.

(4) The university shall not charge any fee, by whatever name called, other than that for which it is entitled under sub-section (3).

Examina-
tions

37.

At the beginning of each Academic session and in any case not later than 30th of August of every calendar year, the university shall prepare and publish a semesterwise or annual, as the case may be, schedule of examinations for each and every course conducted by it and shall strictly adhere to the schedule.

Explanation.- "Schedule of Examination" means a table giving details about the time, day and date of the commencement of each paper which is a part of a scheme of examinations and shall also include the details about the practical examinations:

Provided that if, for any reason whatsoever, university has been unable to follow this schedule, it shall, as soon as practicable, submit a report to the State Government incorporating the detailed reasons for making a departure from the published schedule. The Government may, thereon, issue such directions as it may deem fit for better compliance in future.

Declaration
of results

38.

(1) The university shall strive to declare the results of every examination conducted by it within thirty days from the last date of the examination for that particular course and shall in any case declare the results latest within forty-five days from such date:

Provided that if, for any reason whatsoever, the university is unable to finally declare the results of any examination within the aforesaid period of forty-five days, it shall submit a report incorporating the detailed reasons for such delay to the State Government. The State Government may, thereon, issue such directions as it may deem fit for better compliance in future.

(2) No examination or the results of an examination shall be held invalid only for the reasons that the university has not followed the schedule as stipulated in section 37 or, as the case may be, in section 38.

Convocation 39.

The convocation of the university shall be held in every academic year in the manner as may be prescribed by the Statutes for conferring degrees, diplomas or for any other purpose.

Accreditation
of the
University 40.

The university shall obtain accreditation from the National Council of Assessment and Accreditation (NAAC), Bangalore within three years of its establishment and inform the Government and such other



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regulating bodies which are connected with the courses taken up by the university about the grade provided by NAAAC to the university. The university shall get renewed such accreditation at an interval of every five years thereafter.

University to follow rules, regulations, norms, etc. of the regulating bodies

41. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act, the university shall be bound to comply all the rules, regulations, norms, etc. of the regulating bodies and provide all such facilities and assistance to such bodies as are required by them to discharge their duties and carry out their functions.

Annual Report

42. (1) The annual report of the university shall be prepared by the Board of Management which shall include among other matters, the steps taken by the university towards the fulfilment of its objects and shall be approved by the Governing Body and copy of the same shall be submitted to the sponsoring body.

(2) Copies of the annual report prepared under sub-section (1) shall also be presented to the Visitor and the Government

Annual Accounts and Audit

43. (1) The annual accounts including balance sheet of the university shall be prepared under the directions of the Board of Management and the annual accounts shall be audited at least once in every year by the auditors appointed by the university for this purpose.

(2) A copy of the annual accounts together with the audit report shall be submitted to the Governing Body.

(3) A copy of the annual accounts and audit report alongwith the observations of the Governing Body shall be submitted to the sponsoring body.

(4) Copies of annual accounts and balance sheet prepared under subsection (1) shall also be presented to the Visitor and the State Government. The advice of the Government or the Visitor, if any, arising out of the accounts and audit report of the university shall be placed before the Governing Body. The Governing Body shall issue such directions, as it may deem fit and compliance shall be reported to the Visitor or the Government, as the case may be.

Powers of the State Government to inspect the university

44. (1) For the purpose of ascertaining the standards of teaching, examination and research or any other matter relating to the university, the Government may, after consultation with the Vice-Chancellor, cause an assessment to be made in such manner as may be prescribed, by such person or persons as it may deem fit.

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(2) The Government shall communicate to the university its recommendations in regard to the result of such assessment for corrective action. The university shall adopt such corrective measures and make efforts so as to ensure the compliance of the recommendations.

(3) If the university has failed to comply with the recommendation made under sub-section (2) within a reasonable time, the State Government may give such directions as it may deem fit for such compliance.

45. (1) The Sponsoring Body may dissolve the university by giving a notice to the effect in the prescribed manner to the Government and the employees and the students of university at least one year in advance:

Provided that dissolution of the university shall have effect only after the last batches of students of the regular courses have completed their courses and they have been awarded degrees, diplomas or awards, as the case may be.

(2) On the dissolution of the university all the assets and liabilities of the university shall vest in the sponsoring body.

46. (1) If it appears to the Government that the university has contravened any of the provisions of this Act or the rules, Statutes or Ordinances made thereunder or has violated any of the directions issued by it under this Act or has ceased to carry out any of the undertakings given under sub-section (1) of section 5 or a situation of financial mismanagement or mal-administration has arisen in the university, it shall issue notice requiring the university to show cause within forty five days as to why an order of its liquidation should not be made.

(2) If the Government, on receipt of reply of the university on the notice issued under sub-section (1), is satisfied that there is a prima facie case of contravening all or any of the provisions of this Act or the Rules, Statutes or Ordinances made thereunder or of violating directions issued by it under this Act or of ceasing to carry out the undertaking given under subsection (1) of section 5 or of financial mismanagement or mal-administration, it shall make an order of such enquiry as it may consider necessary.

(3) The State Government shall, for the purposes of any enquiry under sub-section (2), appoint an inquiry officer or officers to inquire into any of the allegations and to make report thereon.

- (4) The inquiry officer or officers appointed under sub-section (3) shall have the same powers as are vested in a civil court under the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 while trying a suit in respect of the following matters, namely:-
- summoning and enforcing the attendance of any person and examining him on oath;
 - requiring the discovery and production of any such document or any other material as may be predicable in evidence;
 - requisitioning any public record from any court or office; and
 - any other matter which may be prescribed.
- (5) The inquiry officer or officers inquiring under this Act shall be deemed to be a civil court for the purposes of section 195 and Chapter 26 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973;
- (6) On receipt of the enquiry report from the officer or officers appointed under sub-section (3), if the State Government is satisfied that the university has contravened all or any of the provisions of this Act or the rules, Statutes or Ordinances made thereunder or has violated any of the directions issued by it under this Act or has ceased to carry out the undertakings given by it under sub-section (1) of section 5 or a situation of financial mismanagement and mal-administration has arisen in the university which threatens the academic standard of the university, it shall make orders for liquidation of the university and appoint an administrator.
- (7) The administrator appointed under sub-section (6) shall have all the powers and be subjected to all the duties of the Governing Body and the Board of Management under this Act and shall administer the affairs of the university until the last batch of the students of the regular courses have completed their courses and they have been awarded degrees, diplomas or awards as the case may be.
- (8) After having been awarded the degrees, diplomas or awards, as the case may be, to the last batches of the students of the regular courses, the administrator shall make a report to the effect to the State Government.
- (9) On receipt of the report under sub-section (8), the State Government shall, by a notification in the Official Gazette, issue an order dissolving the university and from the date of publication of such notification the university shall stand dissolved and all the assets and liabilities of the university shall vest in the sponsoring body from such date.

47. (1) The State Government may, by notification in the Official Gazette, make rules for carrying out the purposes of this Act.
- (2) Without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing power, such rules may provide for all or any of the following matters, namely:-
- (a) the manner of making proposal to establish a university and the fees payable under sub-section (1) of section 4;
 - (b) other particulars to be contained in the Project Report under subsection (2) of section 4;
 - (c) matter to be prescribed under clause (d) of sub-section (4) of section 46;
 - (d) other matters which are required to be, or may be, prescribed by rules under this Act.
- (3) All the rules made under this Act shall be laid, as soon as may be after they are so made, before the House of the State Legislature, while it is in session, for a period of not less than fourteen days which may be comprised in one session or in two successive sessions and if before the expiry of the session in which they are so laid or of the session immediately following, the House of the State Legislature makes any modification in any of such rules or resolves that any such rules should not be made, such rules shall thereafter have effect only in such modified form or be of no effect, as the case may be, so however, that any such modification or annulment shall be without prejudice to the validity of anything previously done thereunder.

48. (1) If any difficulty arises in giving effect to the provisions of this Act, the State Government may, by order published in the Official Gazette, make provisions, not inconsistent with the provisions of this Act, as appear to it to be necessary or expedient for removing the difficulty.

- (2) Every order made under this section shall, as soon as may be after it is made, shall be laid before the House of the State Legislature.

49. The provisions of this Act and the rules, Statutes, Ordinances made thereunder shall have effect notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in any other law, for the time being in force, made by the State Legislature relating to universities.



Second Meeting of the Governing Body

GB/2022/02 dated 13th December, 2022

The second meeting of the Governing Body of the Girijananda Chowdhury University (GCU), Assam, was held under the Chairmanship of the Hon'ble Chancellor of the University, Prof. A.K. Buragohain, on December 13, 2022. At the outset, the Hon'ble Chancellor and the Chairperson of the Governing Body extended a warm welcome to the members and called the meeting to order. The Hon'ble members then formally introduced each other. The Chair requested the Vice-Chancellor to present before the Governing Body a report apprising the members regarding various activities and initiatives taken by the University since the joining of the Vice Chancellor and Registrar, i.e. on 17th November, 2022.

Agenda No. 1: Appraisal by the Vice Chancellor

The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, Prof. Kandarpa Das apprised the members of the Governing Body about the activities of the University since its establishment on 17th October 2022, as detailed below:

The academic activities of the University began after the submission of the First Statute of the University to the Government of Assam on 22nd December 2022.

The University came into existence after the Gazette Notification No. LGL.201.2022/28 dated 17th October, 2022, of the Government of Assam, regarding the establishment of the University. Immediately after the Notification, the sponsoring body, i.e. Shrimanta Shankar Academy Society resolved to propose the name of Prof. Alak Kumar Burhagohain, former Vice Chancellor, Dibrugarh University as the first Chancellor of the University and sent the proposal to the Hon'ble Governor of Assam who is the Visitor of the University, for his consideration. On receipt of the approval of the Hon'ble Visitor on 15th November 2022. Prof. A. K. Burhagohain was appointed as the first Chancellor of the University. Subsequently, the first meeting of Governing Body was held on 16th of November 2022, under the Chairmanship of the Hon'ble Chancellor.

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• ***Appointment of the Hon'ble Chancellor, Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor and the Registrar.***

A panel of three names comprising of Prof. Kandarpa Das, former Vice Chancellor of the KK Handiqui State Open University, Assam, Prof. Thuleswar Nath, Principal, Girijananda Chowdhury Institute of Management and Technology (GIMT), Guwahati and Prof. P. Malairajan, Principal, Girijananda Chowdhury Institute of Pharmaceutical Science (GIPS), Guwahati (in order preference) was placed for consideration of appointment as the first Vice Chancellor of the University. After due consideration, the Hon'ble Chancellor appointed Prof. Kandarpa Das as the first Vice-Chancellor of the University on 16th November, 2022, as per the provisions of the Clause 17(1) of the Assam Private University Act, 2007. Further, the President of the sponsoring body appointed Prof. Thuleswar Nath, Principal, GIMT, Guwahati as the first Registrar of the University.

• ***Grant of approval under the clause 2(f) of the UGC Act, 1956.***

Prof. Kandarpa Das, assumed the office of the Vice-Chancellor on 17th November, 2022. The first Registrar, Prof. Thuleswar Nath, joined on 17th November, 2022 and took charge of the administrative responsibilities of the University. The University submitted its application for recognition under section 2(f) of the UGC Act, 1956 to the University Grants Commission (UGC), New Delhi on 18th November, 2022. The University was granted recognition under section 2(f) of the UGC Act, 1956 by the University Grants Commission, New Delhi, vide letter no. F.No. 8-30/2022 (CPP-I/PU) dated 24th November, 2022.

• ***Constitution of the Governing Body and the Interim Academic Council***

Subsequently, the Governing Body was fully constituted under Section 22 (1) of the Assam Private University Act, 2007, with members nominated by the Sponsoring Body. The Sponsoring Body also issued necessary notifications regarding the induction of GIMT and GIPS (Guwahati & Tezpur) into the Girijananda Chowdhury University, Assam.

With the incorporation of three constituent institutes Girijananda Chowdhury Institute of Management and Technology (GIMT), Guwahati, Girijananda Chowdhury Institute of Pharmaceutical Science (GIPS), Guwahati and Girijananda Chowdhury Institute of Pharmaceutical Science (GIPS), Tezpur, the Girijananda Chowdhury University now



has 143 faculty members and 140 support staff and administrative staff, a total of 283 staff with total salary liability of Rs.1,00,27,000 per month (Rupees One Crore, Twenty Seven Thousand).

- ***Constitution of the Finance Committee and draft PhD regulations***

During the last one month, various committees like the Internal Complaint Committee (ICC), Disciplinary Board, etc., of the University were formed. The Finance Committee and other statutory committees are yet to be constituted as per the provisions of the act and the guidelines of the UGC/AICTE/PCI. The University also planned to constitute an Interim Academic Council & Research Council to discharge the statutory responsibility of the Academic Council till a regular Academic Council is constituted as per provisions of the proposed Statute after the Statute is approved and notified by the State Government, in due course of time. The process of preparation of the draft PhD Regulations as per the UGC Regulations 2022 is in progress.

- ***Visit of the Peer Team of the National Board of Accreditation (NBA)***

The National Board of Accreditation (NBA) evaluators' teams for GIMT (Under-graduate course of the Computer Science and Engineering, and Mechanical Engineering departments) and the Under-graduate course of the GIPS, Guwahati, visited the University from the 9th to 11th December, 2022.

- ***De-affiliation of Girijananda Chowdhury Institute of Management and Technology (GIMT), Guwahati, Girijananda Chowdhury Institute of Pharmaceutical Science (GIPS) from the Assam Science and Technology University (ASTU)***

The University will be applying to ASTU for NOC and de-affiliation of Girijananda Chowdhury Institute of Management and Technology (GIMT), Guwahati and Girijananda Chowdhury Institute of Pharmaceutical Science (GIPS) (Guwahati & Tezpur) w.e.f. 2023-2024. The University has prepared the application for membership in the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) and all necessary formalities have been observed in this regard.

Resolution: GB/2022/02/01: The Governing Body considered the appraisal report of the Vice Chancellor and resolved to accept it.

Agenda item No. 2: Consideration of the **First Statute (Annexure I)** of Girijananda Chowdhury University as per section 30 (2) of the Assam Private Universities act, 2007 for Adoption



The draft of the First Statute of the University was placed before Governing Body for consideration and approval. The Hon'ble members had a thread-bare discussion on all the draft chapters and clauses. Observations and minor modifications as suggested by the members were made in the draft resolution (Annexure I).

Resolution: GB/2022/02/02: The Governing Body considered the draft Statute and after discussion and deliberations, resolved to approve it with certain modifications. The Statute may be sent to the Government of Assam after incorporating the modifications suggested by the members.

Agenda item No. 3: Financial plan of the University for the session 2023-2024

The meeting discussed the statutory provisions with respect to the maintenance and management of the accounts of the University under the provisions of the sections 12 & 13 of the Assam Private Universities Act, 2007 and advised that the University Chartered Accountant (CA) may be consulted for working out the details of the accounting system for the University.

The members also discussed the modus operandi of the student fee collection and deposition with respect to the students to be admitted to the various academic programs that are being launched by the Girijananda Chowdhury University (GCU), Assam.

Resolution; No. GB/2022/02/03 – After due deliberations, the members resolved that an interim budget for the University may be prepared for the months of January – March, 2023.

From 1st April, 2023, all deposits and expenditures of the University have to be streamlined.

- The Governing Body **resolved that** the Finance Committee be authorized to work out detailed a plan for the management of accounts of the University as per sections 12 & 13 of the Assam Private Universities Act, 2007, in consultation with the University Chartered Accountant (CA). The Finance Committee shall decide the detailed plan for the University Accounting system.
- The Governing Body **further resolved** that the fees to be collected from the programmes to be launched by the University shall be collected in the University account. The University budget is to be prepared in the month of February-March, 2023. The interim budget for January – March, 2023 & full budget for the financial year 2023-2024 are to be prepared and placed before the Finance Committee, GCU, for approval. The Governing Body authorized the Finance Committee to finalize the Budget.

Agenda item No. 4: Proposal for launching academic programmes including the PhD program from January, 2023

The Chairperson requested the Vice Chancellor to place the proposals for launching various academic programs in the University.

Professor Kandarpa Das, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor while placing the proposal for the academic programs for consideration of the Governing Body stated that, the proposal for the programs is being made after careful consideration of the demands of qualified human resources in the proposed subjects and the sustainability of the same in the long run. The members then discussed about the following academic programmes placed for due consideration.

1. PhD in Engineering (in different disciplines), Management, Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Pharmaceutical Science and other disciplines subject to the availability of qualified supervisors
2. LLM
3. BPT & MPT
4. BMLT & MMLT
5. MBA (Executive)
6. Certificate/Diploma

The draft regulations for the under-graduate programmes are also being prepared and will be placed in the next Interim Academic Council meeting.

Resolution. No. GB/2022/02/04 – After due deliberations, the Members resolved that the academic departments shall frame the curriculum for the proposed programmes to be launched from January, 2023 and place them before the Academic Council for approval. For PhD programmes to be launched, preparation of PhD Regulations and recognition of PhD supervisors of the University shall be planned and placed before the Academic Council and Board of Management for approval.

Agenda item No. 5: Consideration of Constituent Institutes and Formation of the Schools of Studies and Academic Departments.

In view of the formation and establishment of the University departments, Schools of Studies and the Academic Departments, the members of the Governing Body had a detailed discussion and resolved to adapt the resolution.



Resolution. No. GB/2022/02/05: After discussions, it was resolved that in the initial phase, the University shall proceed with the following Constituent Institutes and Schools of Studies under Sec. 21(4) & 25 of the Assam Private University Act, 2007:



Ms. Sujata Chowdhury could not attend the meeting due to preoccupation. At the outset, Vice Chancellor welcomed the members of the Board of Management to the first meeting of the Board and introduced the honourable members.

Agenda No. 1: Appraisal by the Vice Chancellor

The Vice Chancellor apprised the members of the Board of Management about the activities that took place during the last two months since the University was formally launched. The following activities and action taken were reported for kind appraisal of the members. The Vice Chancellor informed that the academic activities of the University started after submission of the First Statute of the University to the Government of Assam on 22-12-2022. The University received the UGC approval under section 2 (f) of the UGC Act, 1956 on 24-11-2022.

An interim Academic Council has been constituted to discharge the statutory responsibility of the Academic Council till it is formed after the First Statute is approved and notified by the Government of Assam. The first meeting of the interim Academic Council was held today i.e. 13th January, 2023.

The university has already applied to ASTU for NOC and de-affiliation of GIMT, Guwahati and GIPS (Guwahati & Tezpur) w.e.f. 2023-2024.

The University has obtained membership of the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) w.e.f. 24th November, 2022 and all necessary formalities have been observed in this regard.

As per decision of the meeting of the Governing body, special Self appraisal reports have been collected from all faculty members of the GIMT (Guwahati) and GIPS (Guwahati & Tezpur) to take a decision regarding incorporation of the faculty into Girijananda Chowdhury University.

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Applications for promotion (under CAS, UGC/AICTE) of the faculty members for placing them in higher grade under GCU have also been invited and they are being processed.

The preparations for launching of the PhD programme in January, 2023 are almost done and it has been placed in the agenda of the Academic Council. Applications for Ph.D. Supervisors were also invited and list of PhD supervisors have been recommended for consideration of the BOM today. GIMT and GIPS faculty members were engaged in various University activities and during this period the following appointments were done in order to carry out various responsibilities:

Apart from this, the University also made the following appointment for urgent administrative requirement,

1. Secretary to Chancellor; 2. Secretary to Vice-Chancellor and one 3. Administrative Executive
An Academic Coordination Cell has been formed to coordinate with the academic departments for development of programmes to be launched and other academic works during the transition period.

Admission Committee for planning and execution of the admissions for the session 2023-2024 has already been formed and it has already started functioning. Faculty members have so far visited around 100 schools and colleges as a part of admission promotion. Target is to visit more schools/colleges by June/July.

The University shall participate in the Platinum Jubilee celebration of Netaji Vidyapith Railway Higher Secondary School, Maligaon during 21 -23 January 2023 as a part of promotional activity. Preparation for launching of new programmes in Humanities, Social Sciences, Life Sciences etc, are going on. It would be placed before the academic Council for approval. We are also planning to organize a Workshop to prepare a roadmap for Humanities & Social Sciences in tune with the NEP 2020.

The NBA accreditation team visited the GIMT and GIMT and we are yet to receive the final results about accreditation.

The curriculum for BSc in MLT is ready and it was placed before the Academic Council today and approved by the AC.

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The process of development of undergraduate curriculum in Engineering and Management are in progress. This is done in tune with the NEP 2020 and UGC undergraduate framework 2022. The Undergraduate Regulations for the University as per NEP 2020 will be ready soon.

Resolution: BOM/2023/01/01: The Board of Management noted the appraisal report of the Vice Chancellor and resolved to accept it.

Agenda No. 2: Adoption of the First Ordinances of the University

The first Ordinances of Girijananda Chowdhury University were prepared by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor and was placed before the Board of Management for consideration and approval. It would be submitted to the State government after being approved by the Board of Management. The Members observed and discussed the ordinances in-depth and suggested various modifications/additions.

Resolution: BOM/2023/01/02: After deliberations, the Board of Management unanimously resolved to approve the First Ordinances of the University and send to the State Government for approval and notifications.

FIRST ORDINANCES

GIRIJANANDA CHOWDHURY UNIVERSITY, ASSAM

(Made as per section 32 (2) of Assam Private University Act, 2007)

Approved by the Board of Management in its meeting dated 13th January, 2023 vide
Resolution No. BOM/2023/01/02


ORDINANCE I:

ADMISSIONS OF STUDENTS AND THEIR ENROLMENT RECORD

(As per section 32 (1) (a) of Assam Private University Act, 2007)

1.1 Admission of Students

- Admission to the University shall strictly be made on the basis of merit.
- Seats for admission in the university of students belonging to scheduled Castes (SC), scheduled Tribes (ST), Other Backward Classes (OBC), Economically Weaker Sections (EWS), women and differently-abled students shall be reserved as per the policy of the State government.
- Admission of the candidates relating to the category- Non-Resident Indians (NRIs), Persons of Indian Origin (PIO), Overseas Citizens of India (OCI) and Foreign Nationals


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- shall be made as per the policy laid down by the Government of India and/or other Regulatory Bodies from time to time. The University may earmark at least two seats (supernumery) for those category of students.
- d. The procedure for the selection of students to various programmes of study at the University shall be Programme dependent. The University shall comply with the guidelines given by the state and the central government as well as the various state and central selection agencies for selecting students for admission to the courses of study at the University. Eligibility requirements and procedures for admission laid down by the regulating bodies shall be followed.
 - e. Wherever necessary, the Girijananda Chowdhury University, Assam shall conduct its own entrance examination for admissions into various programmes of study.
 - f. The conditions of minimum eligibility with respect to educational qualifications, age and other requirements shall be declared well in advance by the Admission Committee for each academic programme and admissions to various programmes shall be made subject to fulfilment of these requirements.
 - g. The Admission Committee will frame the regulations for admissions to the University including academic norms, fixed number, and last date for admission and shall deal in general, with all matters relating to the admission of students. The Committee may appoint such number of Sub-committees, as it deems fit.
 - h. A student shall be recognised as a member of the University as soon as she/he get enrolled for a degree, diploma or other academic programmes duly instituted by the University.
 - i. A student shall be recognised as a bonafide student of a teaching department of the University or of a constituent campus, as the case may be, as soon as his/her name has been entered into the Register of the School/Department on payment of the prescribed fees after being duly admitted; Provided that the admission of a student can be cancelled at any time, if the same has been made in contravention of the ordinances or of the instructions issued by the Admission Committee or if the admission has been procured by fraud, misrepresentation or concealment of facts.
 - j. A student enrolled for an academic programme in this University or any other University/institution in India or abroad shall be eligible to pursue another programme simultaneously in this University as per UGC Regulations 2022.
 - k. A student enrolled in a programme in any discipline of the University may also pursue another programme in another discipline of this University simultaneously, provided the teaching-learning activities do not overlap during the course of the study.

1.2 Enrolment of Students

- a. No one shall be admitted to any examination of the University unless he/she is enrolled as a student of the University.
- b. A student shall be required to complete the programme enrolled within the stipulated period as prescribed in the Regulations failing which the enrolment in the University shall be forfeited.
- c. The University shall maintain programme-wise unique enrollment number of all the students enrolled in the University.

1.3. Multi-entry and multi-exit policy:

- i. The University shall follow the multi-entry and multi-exit policy for the enrollment of students into various UG and PG programmes as per principles laid down under the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020.
- ii. A student of the University who want to exit from a particular programme after having completed certain semesters and accrued a certain number of credits may be allowed to do so as per provisions laid down in the Regulations. The award of a Certificate, Diploma or Degree for those candidates shall be governed by the respective Regulations of the programmes concerned.

ORDINANCE 2:

**PROGRAMMES OF STUDY LEADING TO DEGREES, DIPLOMAS AND
CERTIFICATES OF THE UNIVERSITY**

(As per section 32 1(b) of Assam Private University Act, 2007)

1. The Girijananda Chowdhury University, Assam shall offer modern, innovative and integrated programmes of studies in various disciplines of Science, Technology, Humanities, Social Sciences, Liberal Arts, Law and other disciplines of studies, which contribute to the creation of new knowledge and have strong relevance to the development and growth of the human society, leading to Doctorate, Masters, Bachelor's degrees as well as diplomas and certificates etc. All programmes to be offered by the University shall strictly follow the principles of the National policies on education of the Country and Regulations set by various regulatory bodies from time to time.
2. The University shall also offer post-doctoral research degree programmes in its chosen areas which shall give a lively edge and substance to its degrees and diploma programmes.
3. The University, subject to the statutory provisions, if any, shall offer programmes in regular (face to face), blended, distance and online mode leading to degree, diploma and certificate programmes in various disciplines on the recommendation of the statutory bodies of the University.
4. The University shall adopt an interdisciplinary and cafeteria-style approach (along with CBCS) for the delivery of various programmes of studies. All students enrolled into various programmes under the University shall be allowed to choose courses beyond their disciplinary barrier in addition to their core courses of study subject to the provisions of the Regulations framed for various programmes of studies from time to time.
5. The University shall follow a credit-based evaluation system with adequate provisions for credit transfer from SWAYAM-based courses or courses completed in another University/institution. The University shall follow the Academic Bank of Credit (ABC) envisaged by the NEP 2020. The University shall follow a ten-point grading system as per the UGC guideline to be specified in the Regulations.

Girijananda Chowdhury University Assam may offer any other programmes covered by the nomenclature of degrees as stated above and in conformity with various Regulatory bodies. The programmes leading to the award of degrees/diplomas/certificates shall be offered after due approval of the statutory bodies of the University.

ORDINANCE 3:

(THE AWARD FOR THE DEGREES, DIPLOMAS, CERTIFICATES AND OTHER ACADEMIC DISTINCTIONS, THE MINIMUM QUALIFICATION FOR THE SAME AND THE MEANS TO BE TAKEN RELATING TO THE GRANTING AND OBTAINING OF THE SAME)

(As per section 32 1(c) of Assam Private University Act, 2007)

- 3.1 The nomenclature of various degrees/ diplomas/ certificates and other academic distinctions shall be in accordance with the nomenclature prescribed by the University Grants Commission (UGC) under section 22 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 and other applicable laws, if any.
- 3.2 The structure of the academic programmes and their duration shall be in accordance with the norms and standards prescribed under applicable laws and guidelines by the concerned Central and State Regulatory Bodies.
- 3.3. The University may offer programmes that are covered by the nomenclature of various degrees/ diplomas/ certificates and other academic distinctions as stated in Ordinance 2.
- 3.4. The nomenclature of various degrees/ diplomas/ certificates and other academic distinctions to be awarded by the University shall be in accordance with the nomenclature prescribed by the University Grants Commission under section 22 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 and other applicable laws, if any and as stated in Ordinance 2.
- 3.5. For the award of degrees/ diplomas/ certificates and other academic distinctions, the evaluation of a student will be done on the basis of continuous and comprehensive assessment and evaluation. Thus, there shall be continuous evaluation of the student through seminar work, project work, practical, sessional work and unit tests during the semester/trimester and there shall be an End Semester/Trimester examination at the end of each Semester/Trimester. The final results shall be worked out by combining the marks of the continuous evaluation and of the End Semester/End Trimester examinations.

- 3.6. The degrees/ diplomas/ certificates and other academic distinctions for various programmes shall be granted to the students or the students shall obtain the necessary degrees/ diplomas/ certificates and other academic distinctions after successful completion of all the academic requirements of the programme enrolled and shall be qualified for the award of degrees/ diplomas/ certificates and other academic distinctions by the University in the concerned subject.
- 3.7. A student may be given a provisional certificate to the above effect by the Registrar after the declaration of the results of his/ her final Examinations on fulfilment of the credit requirement. However, the degree shall be conferred on him/her at the immediate next Convocation of the University.
- 3.8. The University may also confer Honorary Doctorate Degrees (DLitt, DSc, PhD etc) to distinguished personalities who have made a significant contribution to society at the Convocation organised by the University. The procedures and norms about conferment of honorary degrees are specified in the First Statute of the University.

ORDINANCE 4:

(THE CONDITIONS FOR AWARD OF FELLOWSHIP, SCHOLARSHIP, STIPENDS AND PRIZES)

(As per section 32 I(d) of Assam Private University Act 2007)

- 4.1. Scholarships, fellowships, stipends, prizes etc. shall be instituted as specified by the Academic Council and approved by the Board of Management of the University. The eligibility criteria for the awards, their values and where required, their tenure methodology and procedure for selection of awardees, shall be approved by the Board of Management on the recommendations of the Academic Council.
- 4.2. In order to encourage meritorious and deserving students to pursue programmes of studies and research in the University without great financial strain, the University shall strive to provide adequate number of Scholarships, Fellowships, Studentships and Free-ships as well as provide award of Medals and Prizes.
- 4.3. There shall be instituted Scholarships in every subject to be awarded to the students of the University (wherever applicable) subject to the availability of funds. Details for the award of the same will be laid down in the Regulations.
- 4.4. The University may institute fee concession in the form of half and full Free-ships of the tuition fee in each School and teaching department as per norms of the University.
- 4.5. There may also be a scheme of merit scholarship, subject to the availability of funds, where the first and second-rank holders in every programme will be awarded a scholarship, the quantum of which shall be decided by the University from time to time.
- 4.6. All types of Scholarships shall be administered by the Board of Management on recommendations of the Academic Council.
- 4.7. There may be a scheme to award medals/ prizes to the meritorious students of the University for their Best Performance in various University Examinations.
- 4.8. Detailed Guidelines shall be framed from time to time by the Academic Council governing the administration of Scholarships, Free-ships, Fellowships, Medals and other such endowments created in the University.
- 4.9 Award of Medals and Certificates for the Position Holders**
- One Gold Medal will be awarded annually to the graduate securing the highest CGPA in each of the Under Graduate (Hons/Research)/ PG Degree programmes and completing the programme without any backlog or being placed under Academic probation subject to the conditions that he/she secures minimum CGPA of 7.5 in a ten point scale.
 - Each Gold Medal shall bear the University Crest and an inscription giving the name and the year of the awardee as well as the programme.


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- iii. The medals will be presented at the convocation held for the award of degrees for the concerned batch of students.

4.10 Criteria for medals and certificates

For Masters Programs:

- If the total number of students in the particular postgraduate program/branch is less than 5, no medal will be awarded.
- If the total number of students in a particular postgraduate program/branch is between 6 to 19 then the topper will get a gold medal and Certificate.
- If the total number of students in a particular postgraduate program/branch is 20 and above then the topper will get a gold medal & certificate and the second position holder will get a silver medal and certificate.
- Provided the student secures a minimum CGPA of 7.5 for gold and 7.0 for Silver in a ten point scale.

For Bachelor Program in Engineering:

- If the total number of students in the bachelor program/branch in the whole Faculty is less than 5, then no medal will be awarded.
- If the total number of students in a particular branch/program is between 5 to 19 then the topper will get a gold medal.
- If the total number of B.Tech. Students in all the branches in the whole Faculty is 20 and above then the topper will get a gold medal. A silver medal will be awarded to each branch topper in the branch in which the topper has been awarded a gold medal; there shall be no silver medal.
- Provided the student secures a minimum CGPA of 7.5 for gold and 7.0 for Silver in a ten point scale

For other Bachelors Programs:

- If the total number of students in a particular bachelor's program is less than 5, then no medal will be awarded.
- If the total number of students in a particular branch/program is between 5 to 9 then the topper will get a gold medal.
- If the total number of students in the particular bachelor's program in the whole Faculty is 10 and above then the topper will get a gold medal and the second position holder will get a silver medal.
- Provided the student secures a minimum CGPA of 7.5 for gold and 7.0 for Silver in a ten point scale


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ORDINANCE 5:

(THE CONDUCT OF EXAMINATIONS, INCLUDING THE TERMS OF OFFICE, AND MANNER OF APPOINTMENT AND DUTIES OF EXAMINING BODIES, EXAMINERS AND MODERATORS)

(As per section 32 1(e) of Assam Private University Act, 2007)

5.1. The Conduct of Examination

5.1.1. At the beginning of each academic session, the university shall prepare and publish an Academic Calendar consisting of the details of the teaching-learning-evaluation activities, schedule for extracurricular activities, schedule of examinations and declaration of the results of each and every programme offered by various Schools/Centres and shall strictly adhere to the schedule.

5.1.2. The continuous assessment and evaluation of students shall be conducted by the respective schools/Centre under the supervision of the Head of the Department/Centre. The weightage for such assessment evaluation for each programme shall be decided in conformity with the provisions of the various regulatory bodies or policies of the University framed from time to time.

5.1.3. The Term-end Examinations shall be conducted by the Controller of Examinations as per the schedule published in the Academic Calendar.

5.1.4. Provided further that all the records of the continuous and comprehensive evaluation shall be submitted to the Controller of Examinations by the Head of the Department/Centre for preparation of the final results, preparation of the Grade Card and record.

5.2. Terms of Office, and manner of Appointment and Duties of Examining Bodies, Examiners and Moderators

5.2.1. The lists of Examiners and moderators for all examinations except for Ph.D. degrees shall be drawn up by the Schools/Centre. The Dean, after necessary scrutiny, shall forward the same to the Controller of Examinations for approval of the appropriate authorities.

5.2.2. The panel of examiners for Ph.D. degree shall be governed as per PhD Regulations of the University.

5.2.3. The question papers for the Term-end examinations in such subject/course shall be moderated by a committee consisting of the Head of the Department concerned and the subject Expert.

5.2.4. The external examiners/ moderators shall be paid remuneration at the rates to be prescribed from time to time.

ORDINANCE 6:

(FEES TO BE CHARGED FOR THE VARIOUS PROGRAMMES, EXAMINATIONS, DEGREES AND DIPLOMAS OF THE UNIVERSITY)

(As per section 32 1(f) of Assam Private University Act, 2007)

6.1. As the university is self-financed, the main source of income of the university will be from the programme fee that will be collected from the students.

6.2. The programme and the examination fee shall be charged to students for various programmes. The fee structure shall be recommended by a Fee Committee to be constituted as per section 29 of Assam Private University Act, 2007 and approved by the Finance Committee/Board of Management. The Fee committee shall be comprised of the following members

1. Vice-Chancellor - Chairperson
2. Chief Finance & Accounts Officer - Member Secretary
3. A Chartered Accountant nominated by the Sponsoring body - Member
4. A legal expert, nominated by the Chancellor - Member
5. One of the Deans nominated by the Vice-Chancellor - Member

6. Treasurer, SSA Society - Member
7. Registrar - Member

6.3. The term of office of members, other than Ex-Officio members, shall be three years. The committee may co-opt any expert as and when it thinks necessary.

6.4. The committee shall consider the fee structure prepared by the University and if it is satisfied that the proposed fee structure is:

- a) Sufficient for
 - i. Generating resources for meeting the recurring expenses of the University and
 - ii. The saving required for further development of the University.
- b) Not unreasonably excessive, it may approve the fee structure

6.5. The fee structure approved by the committee under section 6.4 shall remain in force until it is revised by the competent authorities and the university shall be entitled to charge a fee in accordance with such fee structure.

6.6. The University shall not charge a fee, by whatever name called, other than the one to which it is entitled under section 6.5.

6.7. The Fee Committee will review the escalation and the levels of fees every year and may recommend changes in the fee structure as it thinks appropriate.

6.8. The details of fees will be decided in subsequent ordinances and regulations. However, fees shall be categorized under the following Heads —

- a) Admission fee (once on admission)
- b) Enrolment fee (once on admission)
- c) Tuition Fee;(per semester)
- d) Identity card fee (once on admission)
- e) Development & Maintenance Fee;(per semester)
- f) Library Fee; (once on admission)
- g) Laboratory including Computer Fee, if applicable;(per semester)
- h) Games, Sports & Recreation Fee;(per semester)
- i) Electricity fee(per semester)
- j) Fee for Co-Curricular Activities; and (Tutorial, Moot Court, Seminar, Workshop
etc.)
- k) Examination fee, as applicable (per semester)
- l) Hostel fee, if applicable (per semester)
- m) Hostel mess fee, if applicable (per semester)
- n) University transportation facility, if applicable (per semester)
- o) Certificate fees
- p) Mark sheet/ grade card fee (per semester)
- q) Any other fees to be specified by the Regulations

6.9. Examinations including Practical and other allied fees shall be deposited either with the semester fees or separately before the Examinations as notified by the Controller of Examinations. Hostel and Mess Charges shall be paid at the time of admission.

6.10. The fee structure for various programmes shall be described in detail in subsequent Regulations. The amount shall be decided by the Board of Management/Governing Body. The fee structure may vary from programme to programme. The prescribed fee shall be published before the commencement of any programme.


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ORDINANCE 7:

(THE CONDITIONS FOR RESIDENCE OF THE STUDENTS IN THE UNIVERSITY) (As per section 32 1(g) of Assam Private University Act, 2007)

7.1. The objectives of the Halls of Residence (Hostels) are as follows:

- a. To provide the students of the University with a congenial place to live so that they can devote themselves to the pursuit of higher learning;
- b. To provide enlightened guardianship to the students during an impressionable age when they are living away from their parents/guardians;
- c. To ensure that students coming from different backgrounds have an opportunity to live together, imbibe a spirit of cooperation and goodwill and acquire a broader societal frame for holistic personality development.
- d. To provide opportunities for co-curricular and extra-curricular activities for all-round development or individual personality and forgiving expression to their artistic and creative talent; and
- e. To develop in the students the capacity to govern their own affairs.

7.2. Residence in Campus:

- a. The students residing in the Halls of Residence shall pay such fee as may be prescribed from time to time.
- b. The University shall maintain such Halls of Residence as may be necessary to fulfil the objectives of the residence.
- c. Every Hall of Residence shall have a name as the University may assign to it.
- d. A Hall of Residence may accommodate a reasonable number of students.
- e. Each Hall of Residence shall be under the charge of a Warden.

7.3. Admissions to Halls of Residence:

- a. All students registered for full-time programmes of study and who are not employed anywhere are eligible to apply for accommodation in the Halls of Residence of the University.
- b. As soon as a student ceases to satisfy the above conditions, he/she will become ineligible for accommodation in the Hall of Residence.
- c. Procedure for allotment of seats:
 - i. Students desirous of residing in the university hall may apply in the prescribed form after admission to the Course in the Department.
 - ii. The Heads of Departments may forward all applications of selected candidates for admission to their respective departments to the Dean of Student Affairs. The applications shall be scrutinised by the Central Committee, which will allot a room in the Hall of Residence to each applicant, subject to availability.
 - iii. Students joining the University for the first time and those from distant places will be given preference for accommodation in the Hall of Residence.
 - iv. The accommodation will be allotted for one academic year at a time. Every student shall submit a fresh application for admission to the Hall of Residence in every subsequent year of study. The applications should reach the Warden of the Hall of Residence concerned at least 15 days before the commencement of the academic session each year. Re-admission will be permitted only after the resident is admitted to a Programme of study and after furnishing proof of having paid all Hall/tuition dues.
- d. Research personnel on projects sponsored by organisations like CSIR, UGC, and ICAR. ICSSR in the University on a salary not exceeding the amount of UGC, ICAR and other recognized funding agencies will be accommodated in a Hall of Residence during the tenure of the project subject to availability.

ORDINANCE 8:

**(PROVISION FOR DISCIPLINARY ACTION AGAINST THE STUDENTS)
(As per section 32 1(h) of Assam Private University Act, 2007)**

- 8.1. Norms on misconduct/breach of discipline
- i. A student guilty of grave misconduct or misbehaviour or of breach of discipline or moral turpitude or ragging or holding of introduction nights or such other practices calculated to harass other students within or outside the premises of the University or hostel, the Vice-Chancellor or the Dean Student Affairs or the Warden or the Head of the Department or the Deans of Schools or the Examination Centre Staff, as the case may be according to the nature and gravity of the offence may suspend from attending classes or be charged fine or be expelled, or 'rusticated' for a period specified or disqualify such a student from appearing in the examinations.
 - ii. An act of gross in-discipline will be examined by a Disciplinary committee/ board comprising board members. The board shall be constituted by the Vice-Chancellor. The committee/board shall have a senior professor as chairman, and two faculty members (preferably one female faculty member out of two). In case, the disputed student belongs to SC/ST or Minority community, then the representative of the faculty members shall be selected from SC/ST or Minority Community.
 - iii. In case of any dispute or in-decision of the Disciplinary committee/ board, the decision of the Vice-chancellor shall be considered to be final.
 - iv. All cases of rustication shall be reported to the Board of Management and the Governing Body for information.
 - v. If a student after having been allowed/admitted for the end semester examination, commits a breach of discipline within or outside the premises of the University, the University may expel the student for the remaining period of the academic session and if this punishment is awarded to a student during the period of or after the examination but before the expiry of the academic year in which the examination is held, his examination may be cancelled.

ORDINANCE 9:

**(THE CREATION, COMPOSITION AND FUNCTIONS OF OTHER BODY WHICH IS
CONSIDERED NECESSARY FOR IMPROVING THE ACADEMIC LIFE OF THE
UNIVERSITY)**

(As per section 32 1(i) of Assam Private University Act, 2007)

- 9.1. The University shall form the following committees which it considers necessary for improving the academic life of the university.
- i. Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC)
 - ii. Grievance redressal cell (as per guidelines of UGC and other Regulatory bodies)
 - iii. Sports Board
 - iv. Examination committee
 - v. SC/ST cell
 - vi. Internal Complaint Committee (ICC)
 - vii. Any other body as decided by the Board of Management/Governing body.

9.2. The bodies as mentioned in section 9.1 shall be constituted by the Vice-Chancellor.

9.3. The composition and the function of these bodies shall be described in detail, in subsequent ordinances and regulations.

ORDINANCE 10:

**(THE MANNER OF CO-ORPORATION AND COLLABORATION WITH OTHER
UNIVERSITIES AND INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION)**

(As per section 32 1(j) of Assam Private University Act, 2007)

10.1. To encourage interdisciplinary collaboration in research and teaching, the university may collaborate with other Universities / reputed research institutions/organizations (AEC, ICSSR, CSIR, ICAR, etc).

10.2. The university may appoint professionals/specialists and faculty members from other Universities / reputed research institutions/organizations (AEC, ICSSR, CSIR, ICAR, etc) as adjunct faculty members.

10.3 The university shall also appoint reputed and experienced professionals/specialists from Industries and research organisations as Professor in Practice as per UGC norms from time to time.

10.4. The university may collaborate with industries and bring in industry experts as adjunct faculty members/Professors in Practice having many years of industrial experience to teach its students.

10.5. The university may collaborate with other Universities / reputed research institutions/organizations in terms of internships for its students and student and faculty exchange programmes.

10.6. The university may collaborate with other Universities / reputed research institutions/organizations, on the recommendation of the Academic Council for the academic benefit of its students. The nature and manner of such collaboration may vary from time to time, which will be prescribed in the MOUs with those institutions/organisations. All other details of regulations leading to cooperation and collaboration with other Universities / reputed research institutions/organizations shall be described in subsequent ordinances and regulations.

ORDINANCE 11:

**(ALL OTHER MATTERS WHICH BY THIS ACT OR STATUTES MADE THEREUNDER
ARE REQUIRED TO BE PROVIDED BY THE ORDINANCE)**

(As per section 32 1(k) of Assam Private University Act, 2007)

11.1. Any matter, which has not been made in the Act or the First Statute, and may be so required; shall be provided in the subsequent ordinances and regulations.

At the outset, the Vice Chancellor welcomed all the members of the Interim Academic Council. Then, the Academic Council took up the items on the agenda.

Agenda No. 1: Appraisal by the Vice Chancellor

The Vice Chancellor apprised the members of the Academic Council about the activities that took place during the last two months since the University was formally launched. The following activities and action taken were reported for kind appraisal of the members. The Vice Chancellor informed that though the meetings of the Academic Council usually take place once every semester, initially, there might be more meetings, as the University is going through a transition period.

The academic activities of the University started after submission of the First Statute of the University to the Government of Assam on 22-12-2022. The interim Academic Council has been constituted to discharge the statutory responsibility of the Academic Council till it is formed after the First Statute is approved and notified by the Government of Assam.


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The university has already applied to ASTU for NOC and de-affiliation of GIMT, Guwahati and GIPS (Guwahati & Tezpur) w.e.f. 2023-2024.

The University has obtained membership of the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) w.e.f. 24th November, 2022 and all necessary formalities have been observed in this regard.

As per decision of the meeting of the Governing body, special Self appraisal reports have been collected from all faculty members of the GIMT (Guwahati) and GIPS (Guwahati & Tezpur) to take a decision regarding incorporation of the faculty into Girijananda Chowdhury University.

Applications for promotion (under CAS, UGC/AICTE) of the faculty members for placing them in higher grade under GCU have also been invited and they are being processed.

Preparations for launching of the PhD programme in January, 2023 are almost done and it has been placed in the agenda today. Applications for Ph.D. Supervisors were invited. These will be placed before the Council for approval.

GIMT and GIPS faculty members were engaged in various University activities and during this period the following appointments were done in order to carry out various responsibilities:

10. Dean (Students' Affairs)
11. Coordinator/ Assistant Coordinator, Academic Coordination Cell
12. Chairman, Disciplinary Board
13. Chairperson, Internal Complaint Committee
14. Chairman, Admission Committee
15. Coordinator, UGC Cell

17. Director/ Asstt. Director, IQAC
18. Chairman, University Student Grievances Redressal Committee

An Academic Coordination Cell has been formed to coordinate with the academic departments for development of programmes to be launched and other academic works during the transition period.

Admission Committee for planning and execution of the admissions for the session 2023-2024 has already been formed and it has already started functioning. Faculty members have so far visited around 100 schools and colleges as a part of admission promotion. Target is to visit more schools/colleges by June/July.

The University shall participate in the Platinum Jubilee celebration of Netaji Vidyapith Railway Higher Secondary School, Maligaon during 21 -23 January 2023 as a part of promotional activity. Preparation for launching of new programmes in Humanities, Social Sciences, Life Sciences etc, are going on. It would be placed before the academic Council for approval. We are also planning to organize a Workshop to prepare a roadmap for Humanities & Social Sciences in tune with the NEP 2020.

The NBA accreditation team visited the GIMT and GIMT and we are yet to receive the final results about accreditation.

The curriculum for BSc in MLT is ready and it would be placed before the Academic Council today.

The process of development of undergraduate curriculum in Engineering and Management are in progress. This is done in tune with the NEP 2020 and UGC undergraduate framework 2022. The Undergraduate Regulations for the University as per NEP 2020 will be ready soon.

Resolution: AC/2023/01/01: The Council noted the appraisal report of the Vice Chancellor and resolved to accept it.

Agenda No. 2: Approval of the Ph.D regulations including course work structure

The draft PhD Regulations prepared by the Academic Coordination Cell on the basis of latest UGC Regulations 2022 for PhD were placed before the Council.

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

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

 - A candidate successfully completing 2-year/4-semester Master's degree programme (After 3 years Undergraduate Degree), with the same conditions as specified above in the sub-clause above;


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- A candidate seeking admission after a 4-year/8-semester bachelor's degree programme should have a minimum of 75% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade on a point scale wherever the grading system is followed. A relaxation of 5% marks or its equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-abled, Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time.
- Candidates who have cleared the M. Phil. course work with at least 55% marks in aggregate or an equivalent degree from a Foreign Institution accredited by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country to assess, accredit or assure quality and standards of educational institutions, shall be eligible for admission to the Ph.D. programme.

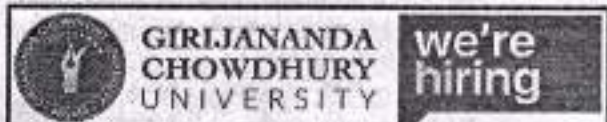


