Invigorating for Intensive Research : Ph.D. Orientation Program at GCU



AZARA, April 11: An Orientation Program for the newly enrolled Ph.D research scholars of Girijananda Chowdhury University (GCU) was held in the Azara campus of the university on 8 April 2023. The orientation program was organized in order to prepare the new batch of Ph.D. entrants for a productive academic journey in the field of research. 35 candidates have been selected for admission to the Ph.D program for the session January 2023. The new batch of Ph.D. candidates also happens to be the first batch of Research Scholars under the aegis of Girijananda Chowdhury University.

The day-long orientation program began in the morning with a welcome address by Professor Chandana Goswami, who is the Dean (Academic) of GCU. The welcome address was followed by a session where the newly enrolled research scholars gave an introduction about themselves and talked about their individual academic profiles. After the introductory session of the candidates, the Honourable Vice Chancellor of GCU, Professor Kandarpa Das, gave a lecture to the audience, comprising the research scholars and the faculty members of the university. In his speech, Professor Das acquainted the students about the facilities and incentives for research in the university. He also urged the candidates to complete their research within the stipulated time, and he further announced that the candidate or candidates who would be the first from the batch to successfully complete her/his or their Ph.D. will be bestowed with a special award, as per the university's plans.
