Having A Field Day: Educational Visit To Health Centres
By Pharmaceutical Science Students of GCU



AZARA, April 29: A field trip to Mirza Community Health Centre and Azara Primary Health Centre was organized for the students of Girijananda Chowdhury Institute of Pharmaceutical Science (GIPS), Azara, which is currently a constituent institution under Girijananda Chowdhury University (GCU), on 27 April 2023. The visit was undertaken in order to give the students an on-the-ground experience of how the healthcare systems operate in a real-world scenario. The field trip group had 59 students and two faculty members from the School of Pharmaceutical Sciences of GIPS- Azara.

At Mirza Community Health Centre, the students were given a demonstration of the Pharmacy section with specific focus on the interworkings of the drug store. A thorough and informative explanation regarding the same was provided, on behalf of Mirza CHC, by Dr. Minakshi Bordoloi, Deputy Superintendent, and Mr. Chinta Haran Kalita, Laboratory Incharge.

Post their visit to Mirza CHC, the students were led on a tour of Azara PHC where they were given an awareness regarding biomedical waste management. The students were briefed on how to remove the hazardous and infectious waste generated from hospital settings. Ms. Monikankana Saikia, along with Mr. Shankar Jyoti Baishya, exhibited the process of biomedical waste management through chemical disinfection, wet (autoclaving) and dry thermal treatment, and land disposal. The field trip came to an end after a resourceful interaction with Dr. Dhirendra Chandra Das, Deputy Superintendent of Azara PHC.



The faculty members who have completed their professional tenure include Professor Thuleswar Nath and Professor Dimbendra Kumar Mahanta of the Department of Mechanical Engineering, Professor Kula Nath Sarma of the Department of Chemistry, and Professor Dilip Kumar Sarma of the Department of Mathematics.
