GCU acquires AICTE approval for B.Tech courses: Paving the way for Working Professionals



AZARA, October 20: Girijananda Chowdhury University (GCU) has achieved a significant milestone in its inaugural year of the academic journey by securing approval from the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) to offer Engineering and Technology courses for working professionals during the 2023-24 academic year. This opportunity is open to professionals employed in registered institutions, organizations, companies or MSMEs with a minimum of one year of regular work experience. Additionally, candidates holding a diploma in any engineering discipline or a B.Sc. degree from a recognized university are eligible to apply for this program. GCU's Department of Mechanical Engineering, accredited by NBA will offer the course with an intake capacity of 30 seats. The primary objective of this initiative is to enable working individuals to continue their education while also providing an accessible avenue for students who may face financial constraints in pursuing higher technical education. Impressively, a total of 137 institutions across India have received AICTE's approval to offer this course. Notably, Girijananda Chowdhury University has emerged as one of the only two universities in the Northeast region to attain this prestigious approval marking a significant accomplishment in the field of higher education in the region.

- Diploma in any engineering branch / B.Sc. degree from recognized university.
