INSIDE BIS: A GLIMPSE INTO STANDARDIZATION AND QUALITY TESTING



AZARA, April 05: A one day exposure visit to Bureau of Indian Standard (BIS) laboratory, House fed building complex, Dispur, Guwahati was conducted effectively on April 4, 2024. A group of 30 students of School of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Guwahati, Girijananda Chowdhury University, Assam under the mentorship of Dr. Trishna Das (Associate Professor, GIPS, Guwahati) was exposed to the area of standardization, Hallmarking & ISI marking. The students were presented with the basic idea about standardisation, its importance in day to day used products along with hands on practical experience of testing the quality of various products. The event was inaugurated by Benjamin Neville Goldsmith (DEO) followed by a description about the aim & importance of BIS by Dr. Rohit Roy (scientist B). Following this the students visited two laboratories in the branch (Mechanical & chemical labs) and had a visual experience of the various testing parameters & machinery that the BIS processes during analysis of various products.
